If you have some playdough, today I would like you to use it to create some 3D shapes. See if you can create a sphere by rolling, a cube by flattening each of the faces into a square shape and a cylinder shape by rolling.

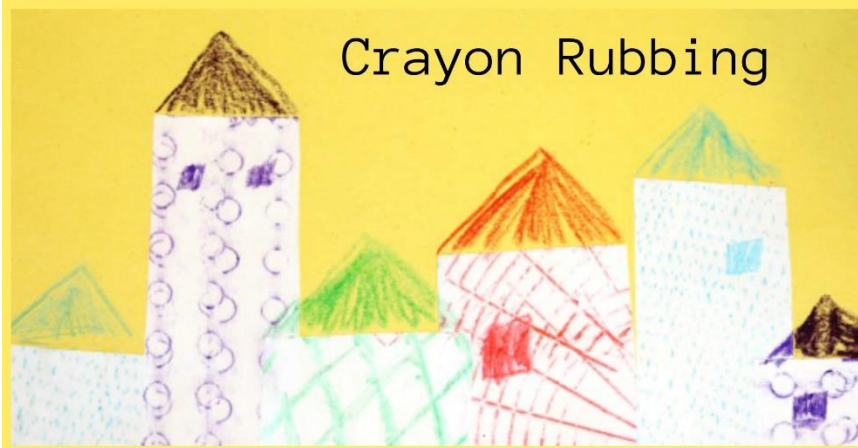
