Get your parents to show you on a map or a globe where in the world the **Caribbean** is. Today I would like you to make an instrument from recycled materials so that you can play along. Make your instrument really colourful.

You could make simple shakers, using cardboard boxes. Take them apart carefully. Decorate the plain side and stick them back together. If you make a couple, fill them with different things. You could use rice, pasta, dried beans, sand, dirt or stones. **Do they sound different?**
