**Computing** We will be learning how to code and write and design programs.

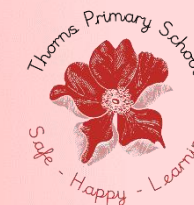
**History** As Historians we will be finding out about the lasting impact of World War II.
