Reception WEEK 5 THEME: IN THE GARDEN | Date: 04.05.2020 MATHS

Today we are going to be thinking about the days of the week just like in the story of the Very Hungry Caterpillar. I know you looked at ordering the days of the week in our themed learning last week and we usually say them every morning in class so you should be pretty good at remembering them by now. Recite the days of the week to yourself or an adult and then I would like you to answer the following questions:

1. What day comes after Wednesday?
2. What day comes before Tuesday?
3. What day comes after Saturday?
4. What are the two days that make up the weekend?
5. What day comes before Friday?

Now I would like you to create a daily calendar from anything you have at home. You could use postits, card, boxes, anything! Get an adult to help you write the days of the week on 7 sheets of paper or card so that you have them ready. I then want you to update your calendar every day this week by putting on the correct day and what the weather is like next to it. It should look something like this:

So by now you should be getting quite familiar with the story of the Very Hungry Caterpillar. I would like you to have a look at the pictures below which represent parts of the story. Adults if you are able to it might be a good idea to print this out. I want you to try and put these in the correct order according to when the events happen in the story. If you need to then watch or read the story one more time to remind yourself. When ordering the pictures you can either print them, cut them and place in the right order or you can simply write the number from each picture in the correct order if you are unable to print.

Once you have ordered the pictures I would like you to choose 2 to write a sentence about, for example if you choose picture 4 you might write "He ate three plums". Don't forget to use your Fred Fingers when sounding out each word.

## THEMED LEARNING

Today I would like you to watch the following clip: What Plants need to grow which explains what plants and flowers need to be able to grow. Then I would like you to go and explore outside and take some paper and a pencil with you. Find as many different flowers/ plants as you can and choose 3 of them to draw. Make sure to look carefully at the detail on each one and try to draw them as accurately as you can.
