MATHS

We are continuing to look at numbers to 20 today, can you count all the way up to 20 using your fingers and toes? Once you have counted I would like you to have a go at the game below. Curious George is picking apples and needs your help to choose the correct numbered apples. During the first few goes it will only look at numbers to 10 and then afterwards move onto numbers to 20.

Once you have helped Curious George to pick the apples I would like you to have a go at writing numbers to 20. Try to make sure you place the 1 first when doing your teen numbers.

LITERACY, COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

I want you to look at the animal sheet below and choose an animal from it. Think about how the monkey in the story Monkey Puzzle had to describe the features of his mummy to the butterfly. Imagine you are writing some clues for a friend to guess which animal you have chosen. Firstly, describe the animal out loud, look closely at its features and what it looks like and then use your phonics to write a sentence or two describing the animal. For example, if you choose an Owl you might say "My animal has feathers" Or "My animal has a beak".
