MATHS- Finding halves and quarters

45 minutes

Today you are going to go on a shape and number hunt around your house. First, you have ten minutes to go round your house and identify any shapes or numbers you find. Whilst finding these shapes it is best if you draw or write them down in your book (so you do not forget!)

Once you have completed your hunt bring back your findings to your grown-ups. Together find half of all of the shapes and numbers you have found.

If you have found a number that you cannot half, work together to explain why that is.

Once you have halved everything its time to quarter it. Same as before if there are any shapes or numbers you cannot put into quarters can you explain why?

Grown-ups- Whilst exploring halves and quarters if there are any shapes or numbers your child has found difficult to work with try challenging your child by putting this around your house.

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THEMED LEARNING- Animals

Grouping animals

Get your child to group animals into two columns. Identifying animals that can fly and cannot fly. What do animals eat? Scientists group animals into three different groups according to what animals eat. These groups are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Carnivores eat other animals, herbivores eat plant material including fruit, leaves, vegetables, omnivores eat a mixture of meat and plant material. (Animals that eat other animals are called carnivores. Animals that eat plants are called herbivores. Animals that eat both plants and other animals are called omnivores).

We have done this activity before so you should remember this from when we were back at school (hopefully!)
