MATHS- Exploring Place Value


45 minutes

Start by watching this video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1F3AycEDksY>

Today could be an outdoor activity (if it's raining you could also stay indoors!)

We will begin to explore the value of different numbers.

Set up this activity :



Use things at home eg two tins of beans as goalposts and write the numbers on a piece of paper. Use what you have available to you.

You are going to shout out a number up to thirty eg and get your child to roll your ball through the tens goal three times. To represent thirty. The ball won't be rolled through the ones goal as thirty does not have any ones. Repeat this activity with a range of numbers.

We are going to have a go at this activity. If it is raining stay indoors and use objects you have at home. Set up three goals with the numbers above. Shout out a number eg 112.

Your child should roll the ball through the goals to correctly represent this number. So they should roll the ball once through the hundred goal, once through the tens goal and twice through the ones goal.



Repeat this with different numbers. You could get your child to teach this game to a sibling, encouraging them to explain each number.
