LITERACY

We have been learning that letters have a name and a sound. Let's remind ourselves of this by watching the song below.

THEMED LEARNING


Today, I would like you to watch this song. It is all about animals living in different places. The place an animal lives in is called it's Habitat. So this song is about animals living in different Habitats across the world.
