Reception WEEK 13 THEME: ANIMALS Date: 08.07.2020

MATHS

Today let's look at adding two groups together. Remember to do this there are a few methods you can use: you could count the two groups together and see what the total is or if you know how many is in one group you can lock that number in your head and count on using objects, a number line or your fingers.

Have a look at this Robot Addition game on the topmarks website:

Begin with numbers to 10 and if you find this easy then move onto 15 and then 20. To work out the answers there is a number line to help you, simply lock the bigger number in your head and count on the other number using the number line. Or if this is a bit too tricky then find some objects you can use to count. Count out both the amounts in the number sentences and then count them altogether to find the answers.


