THEME: AT THE SEASIDE

Date: 01.07.20

MATHS- Multiplication

45 minutes

Starter: Look at the numbers below and identify one more and one less

2, 7, 12, 16, 24, 28, 31, 39, 40,49, 52,58, 63, 67, 74,77, 85,86, 90

Next you will need paper plates or cut pieces of paper into circles. You will be able to explore equivalence through comparison of the paper plates. How many halves can fit into a whole, how many quarters can fit into a half. How



many  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$  fit into a whole.

Discuss with your child a whole, how many  $\frac{1}{2}$  make a whole and then how many  $\frac{1}{4}$  in a half and then in a whole. Discuss this with your child.

Then, leave them to have ago independently and mark together exploring how to improve their sentences or check they have used the correct information.
