MATHS- Money

45 minutes

Hide a coin behind something, gradually reveal the coin. Can your child guess the coin? What was it that gave the coin away? Rehearse coins to 10p. Is there a 3p coin? How do you know?

Make amounts using 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins in different ways.

If I want 20p, which coins can I use?
