THE RAINFOREST

MATHS

45 minutes

Warm up – Use themathsfactor.com to see how quickly you can answer your timestables.

Practise drawing different 2D shapes, using a ruler split your shapes into half. Colour $\frac{1}{2}$ and label it $\frac{1}{2}$. Repeat drawing 2D shapes, this time I would like you to use a ruler to split them into quarter. Choose different shapes, colour in $\frac{1}{4}$ on one shape, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{4}{4}$ and label the fraction that you have coloured. Try for $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{2}{3}$ also. Collect 12 objects from around the house, lego pieces, coins, counters, how many different ways can you put these objects into equal groups? (There is more than one way)!

When you have your lunch today, can you have split you lunch into half? Half a sandwich, half an apple, half a packet of crisps, half a rice cake? Is there anything that you couldn't split into half?

Watch the story 'Under the same sky' read by Tom Hardy on cbeebies. Have a think about who you are missing at school, draw them a picture and write a sentence underneath to say why you are missing them. Keep it safe and then you can give it to them when we return to school.

Also continue to practise your year 1 and year 2 common exception words. Write your words out twice on small pieces of paper. Then turn them all over. Can you find the matching pairs – say the words to the other player as you turn them over.

Using YouTube I would like you to visit 'Virtual Field Trip – Amazon Rainforest.' Whilst watching the video clip please look for the following key words; **emergent, harpy eagle, spider monkey, canopy, camouflage.** When you have finished watching it match the statements below to the five key words I asked you to look out for.

- Helps animals to survive
- Expert climbers
- Builds nests in the emergent layer
- Most animals live here
