MATHS

45 minutes

Warm up – practise throwing a ball/beanbag/cuddly toy to a grown up, each time you catch the ball you must say a multiple of 4. Try this with all the times tables that you know.


Today we are going to be looking at multiplication. Use BBC Bitesize – go on to multiplying and dividing – class clips. Watch the clip of Guy Bagley who explains how important multiplication is in his job as a Lego model builder.

After watching this return to multiplication and division and go onto ‘How to multiply using an array.’ Watch the short video clip and then I would like you to find objects around the home to make arrays, you could even use Lego.

Make an array for $4 \times 5 =$ $6 \times 2 =$ $8 \times 3 =$ $5 \times 10 =$ $7 \times 5 =$ $4 \times 3 =$ $7 \times 4 =$

When you have completed this, write down some multiplication pairs of your own using the household objects to make the arrays as you go.

Eg. $5 \times 6 = 30$ and $6 \times 5 = 30$
