**THE RAINFOREST**

**MATHS**

**45 minutes**

Warm up – Play guess my number. This game is very similar to yesterday you just write a number instead for your partner to guess. Eg. You might ask, am I a 2 digit number? Am I an even number? Am I a multiple of 3? When your partner has guessed their number swap over.

Today I would like you to practise position and direction.

Watch and join in with the upbeat Hip Hop Granny, you will need to visit [KS1 Maths position and directions BBC Teach](#) and then click on KS1 Hip Hop Granny.

Practise this vocabulary and check with a grown up that you understand what each word means; **North, South, East, West, Clock wise and Anti- clock-wise**

You will need a grown up to play this game with you, your brothers and sisters can join in too!

Stand and face your grown- up, this is north, do a quarter turn this is east, another quarter turn this is south and a final quarter turn west. Your grown up will shout each compass point and you need to run to the correct one.

After this, catch your breath and I would like you to draw a treasure map on squared paper. Draw different pirate treasures in some of the squares eg; treasure chest, parrot, palm tree, ship. Then practise writing instructions for how to get to each pirate object.
