THE RAINFOREST

MATHS

45 minutes

Warm up – Practise counting in 5’s with Jack Hartmann (we do this in the morning at school so you can show your grown-ups the moves!). You can try counting in 2’s and 10’s with Jack too.

Today I would like you to design a symmetrical butterfly that might live in the rainforest.
