Easter Chick

You will need:

Orange, light yellow and white card

Chick template

Yellow and orange paint


A sponge

Feathers

PVA glue

Instructions

- Draw around the chick template onto either light yellow card or white card, then cut out the template.
- Using a sponge dipped in yellow or orange paint, sponge print the chick's body and head until covered, then leave to dry.
- Use PVA glue to stick 3 or 4 feathers onto the back of the chick; these should be positioned to look like wings.







- Draw and cut out a diamond shape from the orange card. Fold along the middle to create a triangle shaped beak.
- 5. Using PVA glue stick the beak onto the chicks face.
- Using a felt pen draw eyes on the chick.













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
