

# Easter Chick

## You will need:

Orange, light yellow and white card

Chick template

Yellow and orange paint

A sponge

Feathers

PVA glue



## Instructions

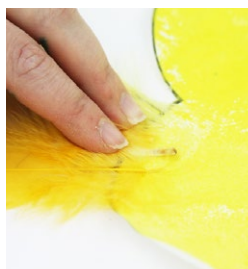
1. Draw around the chick template onto either light yellow card or white card, then cut out the template.



2. Using a sponge dipped in yellow or orange paint, sponge print the chick's body and head until covered, then leave to dry.



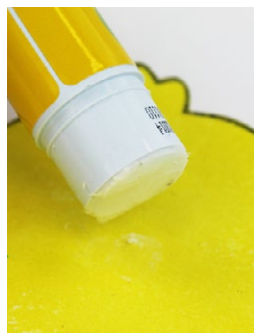
3. Use PVA glue to stick 3 or 4 feathers onto the back of the chick; these should be positioned to look like wings.



4. Draw and cut out a diamond shape from the orange card. Fold along the middle to create a triangle shaped beak.



5. Using PVA glue stick the beak onto the chick's face.



6. Using a felt pen draw eyes on the chick.





### You will need:

Orange, light yellow and white card

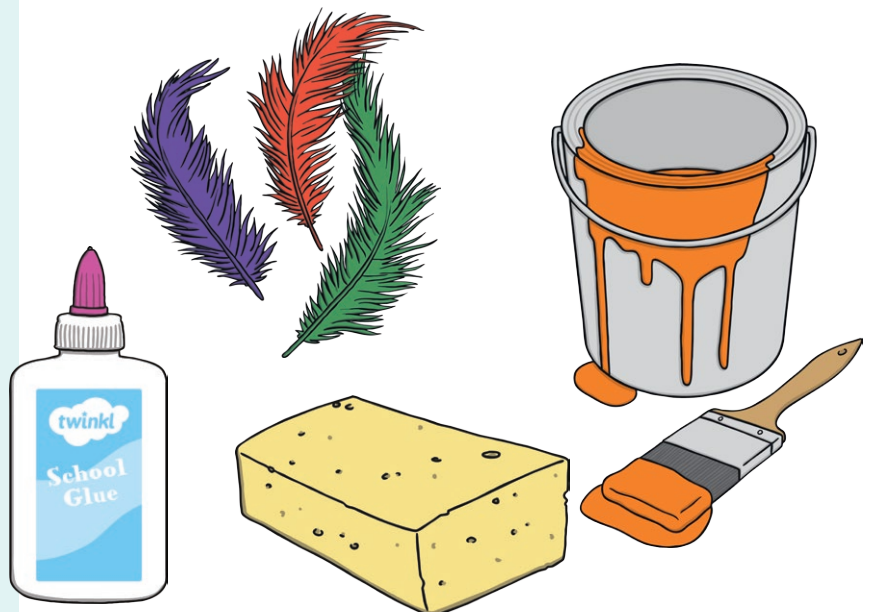
Chick template

## Step 1

Draw around the chick template onto either light yellow card or white card, then cut out the template.



## Step 2

Using a sponge dipped in yellow or orange paint, sponge print the chick's body and head until covered, then leave to dry.





## Step 3

Use PVA glue to stick 3 or 4 feathers onto the back of the chick; these should be positioned to look like wings.



## Step 4

Draw and cut out a diamond shape from the orange card. Fold along the middle to create a triangle shaped beak.



## Step 5

Using PVA glue stick the beak onto the chicks face.



## Step 6

Using a felt pen draw eyes on the chick.
